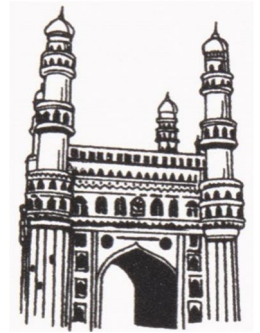

# FACTS ABOUT MONUMENTS IN INDIA

- **Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (CST-MUMBAI)** railway station formerly known as Victoria Terminus (VT) was the first ever railway station in India.



- **Qutab Minar in Delhi** is one of the tallest and famous towers in the world and the second tallest Minar in India.
- **Char Minar in Hyderabad** is said to have hidden treasures in its tunnels.

- **Taj Mahal in Agra** took 20 years to complete. Around 20,000 people worked for the construction of Taj Mahal, used 1000 elephants for importing materials.



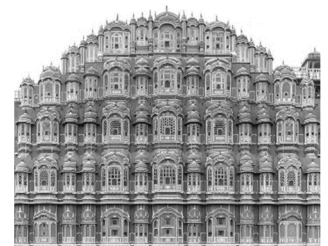
- **Taj Mahal** is one of the eight wonders of the world and the jewel of Muslim art in India.
- **Gol Gumbaz in Bijapur** is said to have hollow walls, known as the whispering gallery.

- **Lotus Temple in Delhi** is a house of worship for every religion and the best place for meditation and peace.



- **Konark Sun Temple in Odisha** is in the shape of a gigantic chariot, having elaborately carved stone wheels, pillars and walls.

- The [Hawa Mahal](#) in Jaipur is also known as Palace of Winds. It has 953 small windows.



- **The India Gate in Delhi** is dedicated to those 70,000 soldiers who lost their lives in World War I. It was completed in 1931 and has names of Indian martyrs carved on it.

- **Jantar Mantar in Jaipur** is even used today for astronomical observations and calculations.
